### Instructions for compiling your PDF application for Rhodes

From the dashboard login page, click on your name to look at your application. You will be "printing" the following sections:

- Preliminary Information
- Personal Details & Contact Information
- Referee Registration
- Essays

Using the tabs on the left-hand side of the screen, select the "Preliminary Information" Tab. From this page, right click and select "print." Then from the print options, select the destination as "save to pdf". Save the file name as "[LAST NAME] Rhodes Preliminary Information" and save the file to your computer. See an example in the pages that follow.

Do the same for each of the sections, saving each one as a pdf to your computer.

Combine the following documents into a single PDF:

- All of the above sections
- List of Principal Activities (CV/Résumé)
- Personal Statement

### **Selection Procedure**

- a. The Rhodes Trust does not require any financial information from applicants, since selection for the Rhodes Scholarship is made without regard to financial means.
- b. Selection for the Rhodes Scholarship is made without regard to marital status, race, ethnic origin, colour, gender, religion, sexual orientation, social background, disability, caste or other irrelevant distinction.

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- c. The Rhodes Scholarship for which you are applying is for entry to Oxford in October 2018 and may not be deferred.
- d. The Rhodes Scholarship is confirmed only upon successful admission to the University of Oxford.
- e. If there is no suitable candidate in any given year, the Selection Committee will not select.
- f. The decision of the Selection Committee is final.

#### Procedure after Selection

- a. Please note that successful applicants will need to apply to the University of Oxford very soon after selection. Full details will be given upon selection.
- b. Applicants for a second undergraduate degree with senior status will need to submit a paper application, provided on selection, which must reach Oxford by Friday, 1 December 2017. Candidates must therefore make a quick submission immediately following election.
- c. Successful candidates will be encouraged to disclose, in confidence, any medical condition or special needs which may require academic or personal support in Oxford.

  This disclosure is entirely voluntary and is requested only to enable Rhodes House to provide suitable support in Oxford and to make the transition to Oxford as smooth as possible.

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## Rhodes Scholarship

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### Referee Registration

Provide list of at least 5 referees (up to a maximum of 8) who will be prepared to write in support of your application and provided detailed information to the Selection Committee:

- i. Furnish the names and email addresses of all your referees.
- ii. Choose reliable people who are likely to respond to requests for written reports as their references will be crucial to your application. Ask their permission before listing them as referees and let them know that they will receive an auto-generated email on behalf of the selection committee in due course. Referees will be provided with Referee Guidance (http://www.rhodeshouse.ox.ac.uk/files/USARefereeGuidance).
- iii. At least four of your referees should be academics who have taught you and who can comment on your academic ability and how well they think you would fare at Oxford.

  All academic references should be from persons whom you have received undergraduate or graduate instruction.
- iv. Other referees can include teachers and other persons who are able to comment critically on whether you fulfil the requirements Rhodes set out in his Will and speak to your personal character. A good referee is one who knows you well, rather than a well-known person who only knows you superficially. It is not advisable to get relatives, close contemporaries or personal friends to be referees.

It is expected that all endorsements and referee letters are submitted online, by the deadline on Wednesday, October 4, 2017.

### Institutional Endorsement Requests for Canada and USA candidates only

In addition to the Referee requests, all USA applicants will need to request the endorsement of his or her college or university. Applicants are advised to check their own college or university endorsement process for special deadlines. Institutional deadlines will always precede official U.S. Rhodes Scholarship deadlines. In 2017, Applicants are encouraged to begin the online process early and to register endorsers and referees as early as possible to permit the timely preparation and submission of institutional letters. Institutional endorsements and referee letters must also be received online and are also expected to be submitted by the deadline. Endorsers will be provided with Endorsement Guidance (http://www.rhodeshouse.ox.ac.uk/files/USAEndorsementGuidance).
