The Certification of Finances will assist Vassar College in obtaining complete financial information about funding available to international applicants who want to study in the United States. Strict government regulations, rising educational costs and economic conditions have made verification of financial resources of international applicants essential. Satisfactory completion of the form is mandatory in order to receive a Certificate of Eligibility (Form I-20 or DS-2019) which is used to obtain a student visa.
